Have Christmas Dinner on us!

It's been a hard year, and for some this will be a difficult Christmas. So the churches in this area have decided to do something practical to help.

We have purchased a number of high-quality Christmas dinners from the charity, "The Long Table", which we would like to make available to anybody who would find them useful. It doesn't have to be financial hardship, though we appreciate that this year some may find themselves in that situation, and we are happy if our meals help in that way. Or it may be that the restrictions on meeting may mean you are having a lonely Christmas this year, and can't summon up the enthusiasm to cook a meal for yourself. Or anything. It's up to you... if you think this would help you, your family or somebody you know, then have a dinner on us. There is no charge.

Each meal consists of:

1. A juicy piece of chicken baked in Christmas spice rub [lemon zest, clove, star anise, cinnamon, bay, nutmeg, sage, golden caster, clementine]
2. Sticky roast carrots and sprouts
3. Roast potatoes
4. Hearty bread sauce, made with sourdough
5. Pig in blanket, butcher's sausage rolled and cooked in smoked bacon
6. Pickled red cabbage
7. Gravy

We can also offer alternatives for Vegetarians, Vegans or those with gluten intolerance.

We will do our best to arrange delivery whenever suits you. Meals can be delivered any time between now and Christmas Eve. They will come frozen, so allow at least 24 hours de-frost time when you arrange delivery.
